## Initial funding secured

The building of the new Fenstanton Community Hub has taken a giant step forward. Thanks to the generosity of Cambridgeshire County Council, Huntingdon District Council and Fenstanton Parish Council, adding to the continued fund raising efforts of the Trustees, we can confirm the initial funding required is secured. Our thanks go to all concerned.



The next steps will be:

- ◆ to prepare final, detailed architectural drawings for the planning application submission to Huntingdon District Council
- ◆ the legal transfer of the land from Morris Homes to the Trust.

In addition, the Trustees will be engaging with potential suppliers for the 'build' stage.
