(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF USE)

ORDER 2020/784

NOTICE is given that Cambridgeshire County Council has made an Order pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, the effect of which is to stop any pedestrian from proceeding along Footpath 12, Fenstanton as lies between Fenstanton Bridleway 21 and School Lane.

Access will be maintained to properties affected by this order.

The alternative route for pedestrians will be as signed.

The Order is made to facilitate bellmouth reconstruction, footpath maintenance and associated works which are being carried out on or near this highway and it will come into operation on 1 September 2020 and continue until these works have finished or on the 28 February 2021 whichever is the earlier.

It is anticipated that these works will be carried out between 08:00hrs and 18:00hrs 1 September 2020 to 28 February 2021.

The Order shall not apply to any persons lawfully engaged in connection with any works for which it is made, any member of the Police Force, Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance Service, a vehicle being used by Special Forces during the execution of their duties or to any person acting with the permission or upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform.

Application for Temporary Footpath Closure at Footpath 12, Fenstanton

Your application for the above Order has been approved, and will come into operation on 1 September 2020.

All necessary legal procedures have been attended to by ourselves, the emergency services will be informed in due course and you will be invoiced accordingly.

Will you please note that the proper signing of the road obstruction must be in accordance with the Traffic Signs Manual Chapter 8 and must comply with the Safety at Roadworks and Street Works Code of Practice. Adequate signing of the alternative route is entirely your responsibility. You MUST place Advanced Warning Signs at each end of the highway to be closed at least 14 days prior to the closure informing the travelling public of the start and end dates of the closure.

All signing must be carried out to the entire satisfaction of the area Rights of Way Officer (Telephone Number 0345 045 5212) in whose area the work lies and you should make early arrangements to discuss the signing with them.
